

Distance Learning

Due to concerns with COVID-19, Lanesboro Elementary is going 100% distance learning effective immediately (Monday, Sep. 28th) through Friday, October 9. Below is guidance on what the transition from in-person instruction to distance learning will look like, and what the expectations will be.

Transition to Distance Learning:

- Monday and Tuesday will be transition days. Expect a phone call and an email from your child's teacher to check in and get necessary information out to you.
- As Chromebooks for 3-6 just arrived this week, and K-2 ipads are not here yet, paper packets will be relied upon for these two weeks.
- Wednesday will serve as a pickup day for materials (and possibly Chromebooks for 3-6 grade). Materials can be picked up on Wednesday between 8:00 and 2:30 at the elementary doors near the library.

Expectations for Distance Learning

- Teachers will be coordinating with you on the details of meeting with students via live video conferencing software.
- Video meetings may begin on Thursday, October 1st.
